

FAQs Allied Health Student Accommodation for Placements in the NT

(as at September 2017)

How much does the Flinders NT accommodation cost?

Please note: in most cases students will be required to share bedrooms and/or facilities.

Darwin, Katherine & Nhulunbuy: \$100 per week plus a bond of \$200. Payment is required prior to arrival. There may be a \$55 administration fee charged at some sites.

Alice Springs & Tennant Creek (Centre for Remote Health): There is a \$200 bond and a \$50 cancellation fee.

Alice Springs (per person per week) \$100 for a shared room and \$150 for a single room.

Tennant Creek is \$100 per week for a single room.



What is included in this price?

Bed linen, towels, cooking utensils, crockery, internet and utility costs are included in the accommodation fee charged by FNT.

What costs aren't covered?

Students are responsible for all personal expenses such as food, toiletries, clothing, telephone, entertainment and travel.

In some cases University faculty funding or government grants may be available to assist with travel to and from rural and remote placement sites. Please contact your University placement coordinator for more information.

Who can apply for this accommodation and how long can I stay?

Flinders and non-Flinders University medical, nursing and allied health students on short-term placements (up to 12 weeks) at a site away from their normal place of residence. For exceptions to this, please contact us via the emails below.

How do I book accommodation?

Each Flinders NT site has a booking system. You need to contact the placement or accommodation officer in the town where your placement is located. Accommodation is limited so don't leave booking until the last minute.
