Basic Training Entry Requirements

- Current general medical registration with the Medical Board of Australia or medical registration with general scope of practice with the Medical Council of New Zealand
- An appointment to an appropriate training position at an <u>accredited setting</u>
- Discussed your application and received approval to apply for Basic Training from the hospital or network <u>Director of Physician</u> <u>Education</u> (DPE).

How to Apply

 New and current trainees need to apply prospectively for Basic Training each year.
Trainees must complete their registration

- online (when registration is open). Each application for re-registration must have the approval of your local Director of Physician Education.
- Applications for Prospective Approval of rotations close: 28 February and 31 August.

Total Training Time

The Physician Training Program is delivered over minimum six years (full time equivalent). It can be undertaken on a full-time or part-time basis.

- Basic Training 36 months full time equivalent
 - Minimum 24 months in core training
 - Maximum 12 months in non-core training
- Advanced Training 36 months (see the individual disciplines for further information).
