Since its conception, Speech Pathology education at Flinders has continued to grow, with over 380 students enrolled across four programs each year – Bachelor of Speech Pathology, Bachelor of Speech Pathology (Honours), Master of Speech Pathology, and Bachelor of Allied Health (Speech Pathology). Flinders University remains the only South Australian institution offering postgraduate Speech Pathology education, and more recently, our rural Bachelor of Allied Health (Speech Pathology) offerings in Port Pirie, Renmark and Mount Gambier. Over the last 50 years Speech pathology at Flinders has maintained its currency and industry standing through continued curriculum review and close partnerships with industry.

Speech Pathology at Flinders continues to make an impact at a state and national level with our graduates working to improve the lives of individuals, families and communities with communication and swallowing needs across the lifespan.
