

Assemblage Research Support Scheme

Guidelines and application form

Overview

Assemblage offers an annual research support scheme to support high value outputs of creative practice research projects led by its members. In 2025, Assemblage is offering up to six grants valued between \$2 000—\$5 000.

Applications may be made either individually or collectively, as long as the grant is led by an eligible Assemblage member. In this round, priority will be given to:

- Extension funding to continue a successful pilot project towards a highimpact output and/or research funding application
- Funding that activates Assemblage's research infrastructure, including The Cube ambisonic sound studio
- Projects that extend existing collaborations with industry researchers, leading to high-impact outputs or research applications.

Research should demonstrate alignment with one of Assemblage's research pillars:

- Creative care aesthetics
- Australian creative histories and futures
- Gender in/as performance.

Applicants are advised to discuss their ideas with the Assemblage Director before submitting their formal application. Completed applications should be sent to assemblage@flinders.edu.au by 4pm on Friday 27 June 2025.

Eligibility

At least one of the applicants must be in a balanced or research-only academic role for one or more years at 0.4 FTE or above within the College of HASS. Additional applicants may include other Flinders University academic staff, HDR students, or staff with adjunct or full academic status, including Emeritus Professors, Honorary Visiting Fellows and Honorary Research Fellows. If there are applicants from outside the College of HASS, that College must also contribute to funding the proposed project. Co-applicants from outside Flinders University may be considered, particularly if there are important underlying strategic reasons for their inclusion. In this case, co-applicants from outside the University are encouraged to contribute to funding the proposed project, including through in-kind contributions.

Application and Assessment

Applications will be assessed against the following assessment criteria:

- Feasibility of the proposed creative practice research output
- Quality of research proposal and budget justification
- Track record of the applicant(s) relative to opportunity
- Potential for impact and engagement
- Potential to lead to external research funding
- Alignment with Assemblage research pillars
- Scope to develop teams and build research capacity (both inside and outside the University).

Each application will be reviewed by a panel convened from the Assemblage Management Committee. The committee will then make a recommendation to the HASS Dean of Research for final approval.

Reporting and expenditure requirements

Grant recipients are required to submit a 500-word report to Assemblage at the conclusion of their research project. The report must be submitted to the Assemblage Management Committee within two months of the end date of the research project. Applicants who have previously received research support funding from Assemblage, including through the Seed Grant scheme, must include a copy of their report

All project funds must be expended by the end of October 2025, unless special approval has been granted by the Assemblage Director. Regardless of any further approval, no carry-forward is permitted.
