Scholarships listed below are relevant to Medicine, Nursing and Allied Health students undertaking a rural placement as part of a health degree.

Applicants for the scholarship must: • be an Australian citizen or hold permanent residency status; and • be enrolled in, or intending to enrol in, a Professional Experience Placement topic in the second or third year of the Bachelor of Nursing at Flinders University; and • be able to demonstrate an interest in and understanding of the health needs of Australians living in rural and remote areas; and maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 5.0.

This could be a budget or description of additional costs incurred, such (but not limited to) accommodation costs of placement, travel costs, loss of income due to not being able to undertake paid work while on placement, clothing required for placement, additional child care costs etc. • be undertaking the placement in a location more than 90 mins travel time from both the student's semester and permanent home address.

Selection of the candidate(s) will be made by a panel that will include representatives from the College of Nursing and Health Sciences. The scholarship is awarded at the discretion of the selection panel. There is no obligation to offer the scholarship in any given year, should there not be a suitable applicant. Applicants for the scholarship must: • be enrolled or enrolling in their final clinical placement of an undergraduate Bachelor of Midwifery degree at Flinders; and • be able to demonstrate financial hardship and/or anticipated financial disadvantage as a result of undertaking the placement; and • have a GPA of 4.5 or above; and • not be in receipt of a similar scholarship for the same placement. The scholarship is open to all students undertaking their final placement. Applicants can apply even if the details of their final placement have not yet been confirmed (placements for some students won't be confirmed until after the scholarship closing date).

The scholarship is open to all students undertaking their final placement. Applicants can apply even if the details of their final placement have not yet been confirmed (placements for some students won't be confirmed until after the scholarship closing date).
