How your application is assessed

Degree Apprenticeships have competitive selection processes. Places are limited.

Your responses will be assessed against the key capabilities, skills, and requirements outlined in the position description. Applicants must review the position description associated with this submission before completing this form. This assessment focuses on your readiness for the workplace and your alignment with the role.

Application stages:

- Industry Suitability Statements are reviewed to determine alignment with the role requirements.
- Applicants whose statements best demonstrate suitability may be shortlisted for a phone interview.
- Phone interviews are used to further assess eligibility and clarify information provided in the written application.
- Invitations to Assessment Centres are based on overall competency for the role as determined by employers.

- Why have you applied for this role?
- How do your background and experiences align with the requirements of the role and the Degree Apprenticeship program?

Your responses should focus on employment relevant information and may include:

- Your interest in the role, industry, and Degree Apprenticeship pathway
- Relevant transferrable skills, strengths, and experiences
- Examples of initiative, problem-solving and willingness to learn
- Experiences that demonstrate your readiness for a professional workplace
- How you will manage the combined demands of work and study
