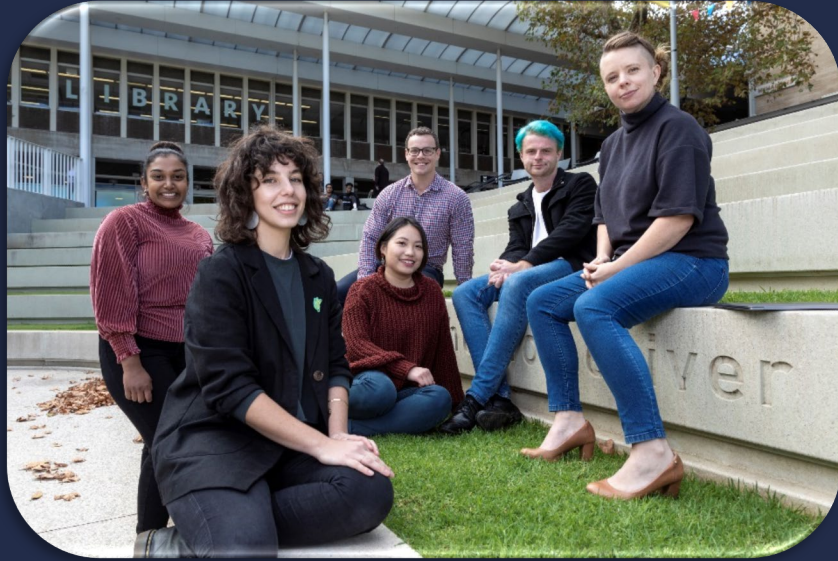

## Unlock Opportunities with our Internship Grant

Flinders University has received funding from the Department of Health and Aged Care to enable service providers to offset the costs of facilitating a Master of Professional Psychology (MPP) internship.

Employers may be eligible for \$30,000\* for each internship to support onboarding, supervision and training.

The project aims to increase access to psychologists and strengthen the psychology workforce, particularly in regional and remote communities, with an incentive of \$5,000 available to support relocation.

The focus of the project is across South Australia and the Northern Territory.

The project team is looking to connect with service providers, including private practices, government and not-for-profit organisations.

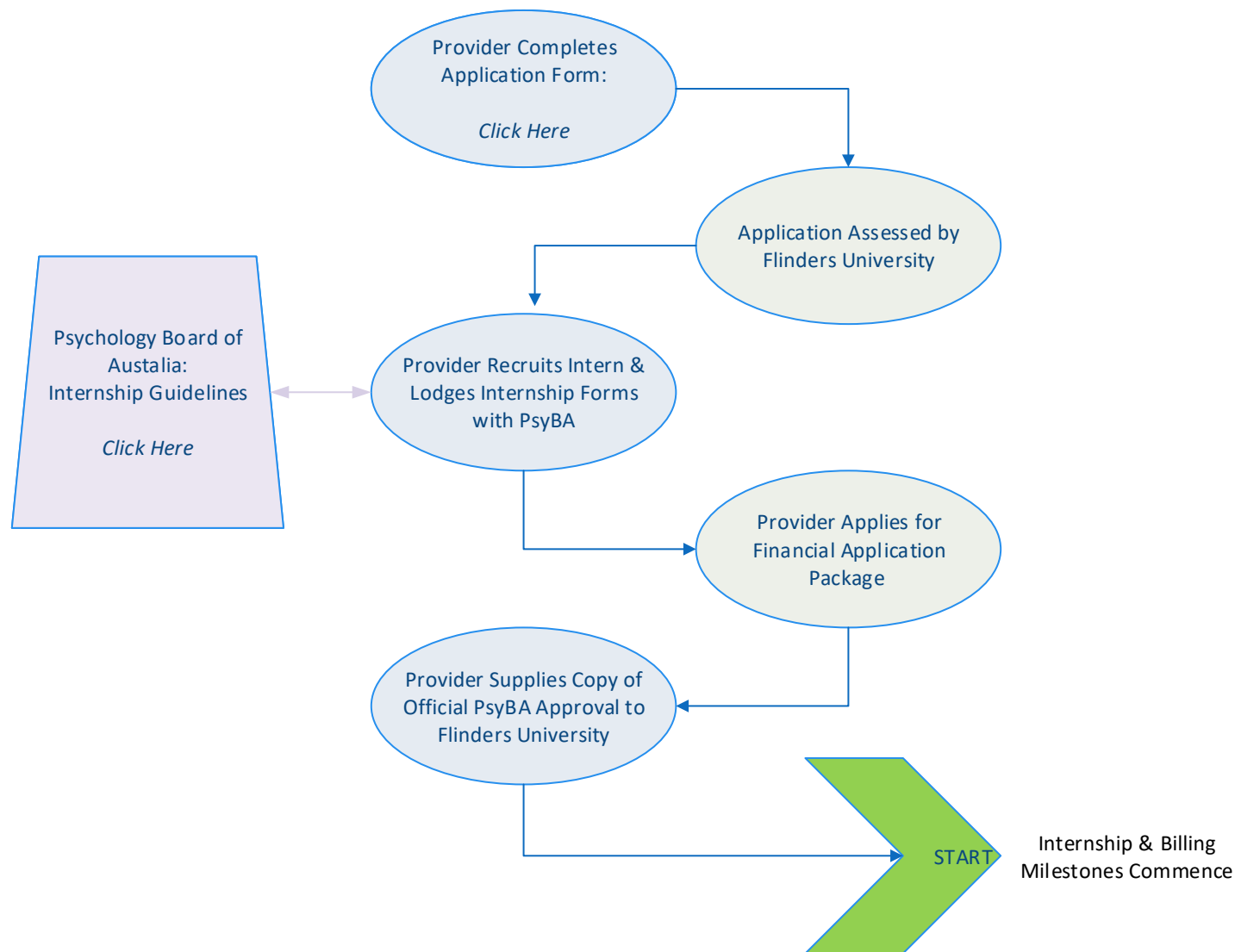
\*\$6,000 is available for onboarding costs (e.g. equipment needs) and \$24,000 is available for supervision costs over the course of the internship.

# Application Process for NMHW MPP Internships



The '5+1 internship program' is a five-year sequence of accredited tertiary qualifications in psychology plus one year (or equivalent part-time) of supervised practice. This final, sixth year of training is referred to here as 'the internship program'.

Flinders University is not responsible for the development, approval or monitoring of interns during their 6th year. The internship plan, approval and requirements are regulated by the Psychology Board of Australia
