

Complete a PhD by Prior Published Work

The PhD by Prior Published Work (PPPW) is a unique Higher Degree Research pathway for experienced researchers who have already made a significant contribution to their field through published work.

This program allows you to consolidate your research achievements into a doctoral qualification.

You will work with an academic supervisor to develop a contextual statement that ties together your publications into a coherent thesis, demonstrating originality, impact, and scholarly excellence.

What's required?

- A substantial body of peer-reviewed published work
- The publications must be clustered and must reveal an arc of research development that confirms an original contribution to knowledge
- A contextual statement (10,000–40,000 words) developed during candidature linking your publications
- Evidence of research impact and scholarly contribution
- Completed your PhD qualifying program at least three years ago

Why choose Flinders?

- Flexible 6-month to 1-year enrolment
- No coursework: focus entirely on your research
- Online mode: complete your PhD wherever you are
- Expert supervision and support from the Office of Graduate Research
- Recognition of your professional expertise and published scholarship
- Domestic students are normally provided a Research Training Program fee offset to cover tuition fees
