## Undertake a PhD Industry Internship

The Flinders PhD Industry Internship program offers short-term, flexible research projects with Industry Partners - remote, in-person, or hybrid.

### Who are Industry Partners?

Industry Partners (also called research end-users) are people or organisations outside universities who can use, apply, or benefit from the research.

They can be:

- Businesses: e.g. start-ups, corporations, consultancies
- Government bodies: e.g. local, state, or federal departments
- Non-profits & Non-governmental organisations: e.g. charities, advocacy groups
- Community organisations: e.g. cultural groups, social services

### Why participate?

- Strengthen your employability by gaining experience across academic and industry settings.
- Foster collaborative research skills and expand professional networks.
- Enhance your ability to communicate research to diverse audiences.
- Drive innovation in sectors aligned with your research expertise.

### Student scholarship support available

PhD students may receive a Flinders-funded scholarship to support their internship participation (pending eligibility).

### What is an eligible PhD internship?

An eligible PhD internship is defined under the current Australian Government's Research Training Program (RTP) legislation, including (but not limited to):

- Formal written agreement within 18 months of course commencement (or 36 months for part-time).
- Minimum 3 calendar months duration, with at least 60 full-time equivalent (FTE) days in Research and Development activities.
- Must be related to the student's research area.
