

Closing date for applications: 9 December 2024

1. Purpose of the HDR Student Publication Awards

- To recognise and reward HDR students in the College of Nursing and Health Sciences (CNHS) according to the quality and impact of the peer reviewed journal in which they have their research accepted and published during their candidature.
- The award amount will be allocated according to the following sliding scale, based on the **2022** journal rank (quartile) in the relevant discipline (subject category) as per the SCImago Journal & Country Rank portal at <http://www.scimagojr.com/journalsearch.php>.
 - \$500 will be awarded for Research published in a journal ranked Q1 in the relevant discipline;
 - \$400 will be awarded for Research published in a journal ranked Q2 in the relevant discipline;
 - \$300 will be awarded for Research published in a journal ranked Q3 in the relevant discipline;
 - \$200 will be awarded for Research published in a journal ranked Q4 in the relevant discipline;
 - \$100 will be awarded for Research published in an unranked journal.

2. Eligibility

- Higher Degree by Research students, currently enrolled in the CNHS, are eligible to apply.
- The full research paper must be a journal article (original research or review) eligible as C1 as per the Higher Education Research Data Collection criteria.
- The applicant must be first author on the research publication.
- The research article must have been peer reviewed.
- The year of publication must be 2023/2024.
- The student's affiliation with Flinders University's CNHS must be clearly identified in the publication (includes affiliation to CNHS Centres/Institutes and Disciplines).
- The student's current Research Higher Degree project must form the basis of the research presented in the publication.
- Each student may only apply for one award per full time equivalent year.
- Each student is limited to receiving a maximum of:
 - four awards during their PhD candidature
 - two awards during their Masters by Research candidature
- Students who upgrade their postgraduate qualification (eg from Masters to PhD) are only entitled to a maximum of four awards. (i.e. the awards received under the former degree are counted towards the four year FTE award limit of the PhD).
- The research paper must be published. An exception is offered to students in the final six months of their fourth full time equivalent year of candidature. For these students only, a copy of the research paper and confirmation of the acceptance date of publication will suffice.

3. Submission of applications

- Applications must be submitted on the [CNHS HDR website](#).
- A PDF copy of the published research paper must accompany the application.

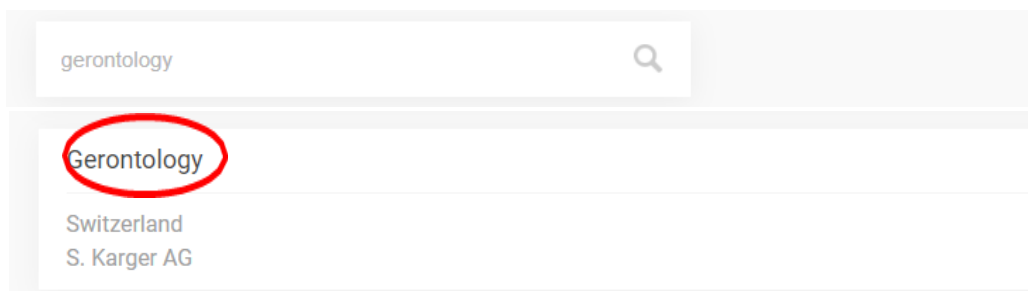

How to find the SCImago Quartile ranking of the Journal in the discipline relevant to your publication.

1. Go to <http://www.scimagojr.com/journalsearch.php>
2. Enter the name of the journal in the journal search engine and click on the magnifier.



3. Select the appropriate journal from the result list.



4. Note on your application form the **2022** Quartile for the Discipline/Category that is most relevant to your publication. Quartiles appear when you hover the mouse pointer over the tiles.

As an example, the journal is ranked in Q2 for both Molecular Medicine and Pharmacology. (Please ensure you provide the **2022** quartile data for your publication.)
