# **Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Student Scholarship**



## **Description**

This scholarship has been established following the creation of a dedicated fund by the South Australian government to support disadvantaged students at Flinders University. Its primary purpose is to support Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students who are undertaking a degree at Flinders University and are experiencing financial hardship.

#### **Benefits**

Each scholarship will be valued at \$6,000 per year for up to 4 years. There will be 10 scholarships available per year.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants for the scholarship must:

- be of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent; and
- identify as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander; and
- be accepted as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander by the community in which they live or have lived; and
- be in receipt of means-tested government payments or be able to demonstrate financial hardship;
  and
- be commencing an undergraduate degree at Flinders University; and
- be enrolled full-time in a Commonwealth Supported Place at Flinders University\*

#### Tenure

The scholarship is awarded for the published duration of the course up to a maximum of four years and is not valid for the postgraduate component of combined degrees. Recipients must maintain satisfactory progress.

#### Leave

Leave is permitted for one semester after the first semester of payment only.

#### Selection

The Scholarship selection will be made based on academic merit. Preference may be given to students who have been involved in <u>The Santos Aboriginal Power Cup Program</u>.

Selection of the candidate(s) will be made following procedures approved by the Director, Student Administration in consultation with the Office of Indigenous Strategy and Engagement.

### **Applications**

Applications can be made online through the Flinders University Student Management System. Only complete applications submitted by the closing date will be considered.

<sup>\*</sup> Recipients who have extenuating circumstances that prevent them from studying full-time (e.g. disabilities, illness, or carer responsibilities) may apply to hold their scholarship part-time subject to the provision of satisfactory independent documentation.
