

Business, Creative Arts, Law and Social Sciences Honours Scholarship for Indigenous Students



Description

The College of Business, Creative Arts, Law and Social Sciences has established an Indigenous Honours Scholarship to promote reconciliation by furthering Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community participation, retention and success in higher education

Benefits

Each scholarship will have a value of \$5000 paid in equal instalments after the census date of each semester. The number of scholarships will depend on the funding available.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent; and
- identify as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander; and
- be accepted as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander by the community in which they live or have lived; and
- be currently completing or have completed an undergraduate degree; and
- be accepted into an honours program, or the final 36 units of a four-year Honours program in the College of Business, Creative Arts, Law and Social Sciences at Flinders University for the specified academic year.

Tenure

The scholarship is available for one year. Payments will be made subject to satisfactory progress. Scholarship payments will be withdrawn if the recipient withdraws or is precluded from the course and will not be available for a repeat year of study.

Leave

No Leave is permitted.

Selection

The Scholarship will be awarded based on:

- academic merit; and
- the quality of the proposed Honours research project.

Selection will be made by a Committee within the College of Business, Creative Arts, Law and Social Sciences.

Applications

Applications can be made online through the Flinders University Student Management System. Only complete applications submitted by the closing date will be considered.

Advertising

The Scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
