Carson Northern Territory Medical Program Scholarship



Description/Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to support provide financial assistance to students enrolled in the Northern Territory Medical Program.

The scholarship is funded by a donation from the Carson Family.

Benefits

Each scholarship will have a value of \$5,000 per annum paid in equal instalments after the census date of each semester. One scholarship will be available per year for the duration of the funding.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be enrolled in the second or third year of the Northern Territory Medical Program at Flinders University; and
- be able to demonstrate consistent professional behaviour and a commitment to working on the Northern Territory.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students are encouraged to apply.

Tenure

The tenure is 1 year. The scholarship will be paid in two equal instalments, after the census date of each semester.

Leave

Leave will be permitted for the second semester of this scholarship, for a maximum of one semester only.

Selection

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of demonstrated consistent professional behaviour and commitment to working in the Northern Territory. Preference may be given to students in financial need.

Successful applicants may reapply in subsequent years; however, preference may be given to students who have not previously received this scholarship.

Selection will be made by a panel which includes representatives from the College of Medicine and Public Health.

Applications

Applications can be made online through the Flinders University Student Management System. Only complete applications submitted by the closing date will be considered.

Advertising

The Scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
