

### **Purpose**

This Scholarship has been established to support students with a disability who are undertaking a degree at Flinders University and seeking to work in a community-focussed career.

### **Source of funds**

The Scholarship is funded through donations from Community Bridging Services (CBS) Inc. One scholarship will be available per year for the duration of the funding.

### **Benefits**

Each Scholarship will have a value of \$3000 paid in two equal instalments after the census date of each semester.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants for the Scholarship must:

- be enrolled in a degree program at Flinders University; and
- be registered and have an Access Plan with Health and Counselling.

### **Tenure**

The Scholarship tenure is one year.

### **Leave**

Leave is permitted for a maximum of one semester after completion of the first semester of the scholarship.

### **Selection**

The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of:

- the extent to which the applicant's studies support their career aspirations; and
- the extent to which the applicant can demonstrate their interest and commitment to a career focused on community engagement and support; and
- the impact the scholarship will have on supporting the applicant in their studies.

Scholarship selection will be made in collaboration with Health and Counselling in accordance with approved University procedures.

### **Applications**

Applications can be made online through the student management system.

### **Advertising**

The Scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
