

Description

The purpose of an Honours Scholarship is to enable a suitable undergraduate student to carry out, under the supervision of a member of staff, appropriate research or other study-related activities whilst enrolled as a full-time student at Flinders University.

These Honours Scholarships are typically aligned to specific research projects and are often funded through external grants or supervisor-held funding. As such, individual scholarships may include project-specific conditions, eligibility requirements, and benefits determined by the supervising academic or College. All additional conditions must be consistent with Flinders University policy.

A scholarship must not be used in place of employment. Activities associated with the scholarship must be primarily educational in nature and directly related to the student's Honours program and must not constitute work that would normally be performed by a paid employee.

Benefits

The value and structure of the scholarship (including stipend, duration, and any project-specific support) will be determined by the funding source and supervising academic and may vary between projects.

Eligibility

Applicants for the scholarship must be enrolled full-time in an honours years at Flinders University*.

Additional eligibility criteria may apply to individual scholarships, including requirements specific to the research project or funding conditions. These criteria will be specified in the scholarship advertisement.

* Recipients who have extenuating circumstances that prevent them from studying full-time (e.g. disabilities, illness, or carer responsibilities) may apply to hold their scholarship part-time subject to the provision of satisfactory independent documentation.

Tenure

The Scholarship is awarded for up to 1 years of full-time study.

Scholarship payments will be withdrawn if the scholarship holder if the student no longer meets the eligibility criteria.

Leave

Leave is permitted for one semester after the first semester of payment only.

Selection

Selection will be based on academic merit and demonstrated suitability for the specific research project. A competitive selection process is required if there is more than one eligible student.

Applications

Applications can be made online through the Flinders University Student Management System. Only complete applications submitted by the closing date will be considered.

Advertising

The Scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined
