Flinders Archaeology and History Society Indigenous Student Scholarship



Purpose

The scholarship has been established to support an Indigenous student to study history or archaeology at Flinders University.

Source of funds

The scholarships are funded by the Flinders Archaeology and History Society and will continue whilst there is sufficient funding.

Benefits

Each scholarship will have a value of \$3000 paid in equal instalments of \$1,500 after the census date of each semester. The number of scholarships will depend on the funding available.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent; and
- identify as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander; and
- be accepted as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander by the community in which they live or have lived; and
- be enrolled full-time within the College of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences at Flinders University; and
- be undertaking a coursework degree in archaeology or history.

Tenure

The scholarship is available for one year.

Leave

Leave is permitted for a maximum of one semester after the first semester of the scholarship.

Selection

The Scholarship will be awarded based on academic merit. Preference will be given to commencing students.

Scholarship selection will be made in accordance with approved University procedures.

Applications

Applications can be made online through the Student Management System.

Advertising

The scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
