

### **Purpose**

This scholarship has been established to provide financial assistance to students studying Primary Health Care (Diabetes Management and Education) postgraduate program.

### **Source of funds**

The source of funds has been donated by Mediserve Nursing Agency.

### **Benefits**

Each scholarship will have a value of \$2,000. Two scholarships will be available per annum until funds are exhausted.

### **Eligibility**

Scholarship applicants must:

- be an Australian citizen, permanent resident or permanent humanitarian visa holder; and
- be enrolled in the Graduate Certificate in Primary Health Care (Diabetes Management and Education) at Flinders University; and
- have a permanent home address in the Northern Territory.

### **Applications**

Applications should be submitted online through the Student System by the specified closing date.

### **Tenure**

The tenure is for 1 year. The scholarship will be paid in two equal instalments, after the census date of each semester.

### **Selection**

The Scholarship will be awarded on the extent to which the student can demonstrate their commitment to working in the Northern Territory in accordance with approved University procedures.

### **Advertising**

The scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
