

The Peter Torjul Interstate Student Scholarship



Flinders University has established this scholarship to support interstate students studying undergraduate courses at Flinders University. The scholarship is named to honour the late Peter Torjul, who worked tirelessly for over 30 years to create educational pathways for students to Flinders.

Up to five scholarships will be available per annum.

Eligibility

Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident of Australia or permanent humanitarian visa holder; and
- be applying via SATAC to commence an undergraduate degree; and
- have their first preference to an eligible Flinders course; and
- be in receipt of means-tested government payments or be able to demonstrate financial hardship; and
- have a permanent residential address in any Australian state or territory **other than** South Australia or the Northern Territory.

This scholarship cannot be held concurrently with other major University scholarships and is not valid for the postgraduate component of combined degrees.

Benefits

The scholarship is valued at \$10,000 per annum for up to four years. The scholarship will be paid in instalments of \$5,000 each semester, subject to the recipient maintaining eligibility.

Tenure

The scholarship is awarded for the published duration of the undergraduate degree up to a maximum of four years. The scholarship is not transferable to another course and is not valid for the postgraduate component of combined degrees.

Recipients must:

- normally be enrolled full-time in a Commonwealth Supported Place in an eligible course; and
- normally maintain a GPA of 5.0.

Recipients who have extenuating circumstances that prevent them from studying full-time (e.g. disabilities, illness, or carer responsibilities) may apply to hold their scholarship part-time subject to the provision of satisfactory independent documentation.

Selection

Selection will be awarded based on academic merit, using the applicant's university entrance score.

Applications

Applications must be submitted through the Student Management System by the designated date.
