Queenie Gibbins Scholarship in Science (Biotechnology)



Mrs Queenie Gibbins, a supporter of the University, has a particular interest in assisting students in emerging areas of scientific study. This scholarship was established to assist with the retention and success of students in these fields of study.

Subject to the availability of funds, there will be one or more scholarships awarded annually to a total value of \$5,000.

Eligibility

Applicants for the scholarship must be:

- an Australian citizen, a permanent humanitarian visa holder or a permanent resident of Australia; and
- enrolled in the second or subsequent year of a four year Flinders University undergraduate Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree (i.e. have completed a least 36 units), or have commenced a Flinders University one year Bachelor of Science (Honours) degree; and
- able to demonstrate financial hardship.

Tenure

Scholarship holders would normally be expected to be enrolled on a full-time basis. Scholarship holders who are approved to be enrolled part-time will be eligible for pro rata scholarship payments based on enrolment load.

The scholarship is awarded for one year of full-time study (36 units) or its part-time equivalent, subject to the scholarship holder maintaining their enrolment in the relevant degree and satisfactory academic progress.

Scholarship payments will be withdrawn if the scholarship holder withdraws or is precluded from the course and will not be available for a repeat year of study. The scholarship will be paid in instalments at the beginning of each semester.

Source of Funds

The scholarship is funded by a donation from Mrs Queenie Gibbins.

Selection

The scholarship will be awarded based on demonstrated financial need and academic merit with preference being given to students studying within the biotechnology field. Selection will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Student Administration.

Applications

Applications should be submitted online through the Flinders University Student System by the specified closing date. Applicants will need to login and navigate to the My Scholarships tab to submit an application.
