

Rotary Club of the Barossa Valley Foundation Scholarship



This scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to undergraduate students at Flinders University. It was established by and continues to be funded by generous donations from the Rotary Club of the Barossa Valley Foundation.

Benefits

Subject to available funding, one new scholarship with a value of **\$5,000** will be offered each year.

Eligibility

Scholarship recipients must:

- be an Australian or New Zealand Citizen or an Australian permanent resident; and
- have resided in the Barossa Valley/Eden Valley Wine Region in the five years prior to commencing university study; and
- be commencing their first undergraduate degree in the year of the award; and
- be enrolling full-time at Flinders University; and
- be able to demonstrate financial hardship.

Tenure

The scholarship is awarded for two years. It will be paid in four equal instalments of \$1,250 after the main census date of each semester.

Payments will continue whilst the recipient continues to be enrolled full time.

Selection

The Scholarship will be awarded based on:

- demonstrated financial need, and
- academic merit (ATAR score or equivalent); and
- the level of participation in school activities and responsibilities and/or community activities in the Barossa Valley/Eden Valley area.

Selection will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Student Administration Services.

Applications

Applications should be submitted online through the Flinders University Student System by the specified closing date.
