Wyndham Richardson Tertiary Students' Care Trust Scholarship Conditions of Award



Background

Flinders Housing has established the Wyndham Richardson Tertiary Students' Care Trust Scholarship to provide financial assistance to undergraduate students residing in University Hall or the Deirdre Jordan Village. Subject to the availability of funds, four scholarships will be awarded annually. The value of each scholarship will be up to \$2,000 which will be credited to the recipient's Accommodation Fee account at Flinders Housing.

Tenure

The scholarship will be awarded for the normal duration of one academic year. The scholarship holder must remain enrolled full-time and reside for the full academic year in University Hall or the Deirdre Jordan Village in the year for which the scholarship is awarded. Scholarship payments will be made directly into the recipient's Accommodation Fee account at Flinders Housing in four equal instalments throughout the year. Scholarship payments will be withdrawn and, except in exceptional circumstances, reimbursement for any previous payments will be required, should the recipient withdraw from their course of study or no longer reside in University Hall or the Deirdre Jordan Village.

Benefits

The scholarship is funded by the Wyndham Richardson Tertiary Students' Care Trust.

Eligibility

Applicants for the scholarship must:

- (a) be Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia; and
- (b) be enrolled, or seeking to enrol, as a full-time student in an undergraduate course of study at Flinders University; and
- (c) be residing at University Hall or the Deirdre Jordan Village for the duration of the academic year in which the award is made; and
- (d) be able to demonstrate financial hardship; and
- (d) not be in receipt of any other scholarship.

Selection

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of demonstrated financial need and academic merit. Selection will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Academic and Student Services. Preference will be given to applicants who:

- normally reside outside of the Adelaide metropolitan area and the metropolitan areas of other major Australian cities (as defined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics Local Council areas); or
- normally reside in the Adelaide metropolitan area but are required, due to special circumstances, to reside at Flinders Housing.

Applications will be made via the Student Information System.
