# Nick Llewellyn-Jones Indigenous Commerce Scholarship



### **Purpose**

The scholarship will assist Indigenous students studying the Bachelor of Business, Business Economics or Commerce at Flinders University.

#### Source of funds

The Scholarship has been established through a generous donation from Nick Llewellyn-Jones.

# **Benefits**

Each Scholarship will have a value of \$10,000 per annum to be paid in equal instalments after the census date of each semester.

One Scholarship will be available per annum for the duration of the funding period.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants for the scholarship must:

- be of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent; and
- identify as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander; and
- be accepted as an Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander by the community in which they live or have lived; and
- normally be enrolled at full-time Flinders University\*; and
- be enrolled in the second or subsequent year of the Bachelor of Business, Business Economics or Commerce; and
- have a minimum GPA of 4.0; and
- be able to demonstrate an interest in a career in commerce; and
- not be in receipt of a similar scholarship.

Previous recipients may reapply; however, priority may be given to students who have not previously received this scholarship.

\*Scholarships are available to part-time students in exceptional circumstances, which include (but are not limited to) disability, illness or carer responsibilities. Part-time scholarship recipients will receive the same annual value as full-time scholarship recipients.

#### **Tenure**

The scholarship is awarded for up to 2 years of full-time study.

#### Selection

The Scholarship selection will be based on academic merit and demonstrated interest in a career in commerce.

Selection of the candidate(s) will be made following procedures approved by the Director, Student Administration in consultation with the Office of Indigenous Strategy and Engagement.

#### **Applications**

Applications should be submitted online through the Flinders University Student System by the specified closing date.
