

Stafford Wulff Scholarship in Paramedicine



Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to support provide financial assistance to students commencing the Bachelor of Paramedicine.

Source of funds

The initial source of funds for this scholarship is donations from two Flinders paramedic graduates, Stafford Wulff and Gabriel Hicks.

Benefits

Each scholarship will have a value of \$1000. Four scholarships will be available per year for the duration of the funding. Should fewer than four scholarships be awarded in any given year, the \$4000 will be split evenly amongst the recipients. Payment will be made in a single instalment after the census date of the first semester of study.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- be commencing the first year of the Bachelor of Paramedicine; and
- be enrolled full-time at Flinders University; and
- be in receipt of a means-tested Commonwealth Income Support payment or be able to demonstrate financial hardship.

Tenure

The tenure is 1 year. The scholarship will be paid in a single instalment after the census date of semester one.

Leave

Leave will not be permitted.

Selection

Selection will be made on the basis of academic merit and financial need. Preference will be given to students who are not in receipt of any other scholarship.

Applications

Applications should be submitted online through the Student System by the specified closing date.

Advertising

The scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
