

### **Purpose**

This Scholarship has been established to assist undergraduate students in financial need.

### **Source of funds**

The Scholarship has been established via a generous donation from The Wise Foundation.

### **Benefits**

Each Scholarship will have a value of \$1500 paid in a single instalment. Two Scholarships will be available per semester.

### **Eligibility**

Applicants for the Scholarship must:

- be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate course at Flinders University; and
- be in their second or subsequent year of studies; and
- have a minimum GPA of 5.0; and
- be in receipt of a means-tested Commonwealth Income Support payment or be able to demonstrate financial hardship; and
- be able to demonstrate difficult circumstances that have a financial impact on their studies; and
- be an Australian citizen, permanent resident, Permanent Humanitarian Visa holder or Temporary Protection Visa holder.

Applications will be accepted from part-time students who have extenuating circumstances that prevent them from studying full-time (e.g., disabilities, carer responsibilities).

### **Tenure**

The Scholarship is a one off-payment.

### **Leave**

No leave is permitted.

### **Selection**

The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need and academic merit. Scholarship selection will be made in accordance with approved University procedures. Preference may be given to Australian Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander students, single parents, or refugees (on Permanent Humanitarian or Temporary Protection visas).

Previous recipients may reapply, but preference may be given to students who have not received this previously.

Applications can be made online through the student management system.

The Scholarship will be advertised on the University website and other appropriate media as determined by Flinders University.
