Dear Colleagues,

As you may recall from my message late last year, extensive work throughout 2025 went into shaping what a new Academic Career Framework (ACF) could look like. I would once again like to thank all those who contributed to this important process through your contribution to focus groups, feedback sessions and the formal consultation process. Your insights have played a vital role in refining a final framework.

Since close of consultation, we have carefully reviewed all submissions, with each of these being de-identified by People and Culture before coming to senior leaders for consideration. The feedback reaffirmed strong support for the intent of the Framework, while also highlighting opportunities to improve clarity, strengthen equity and inclusion, and refine indicator levels.

This feedback directly informed the final ACF and its associated policy material, which has now been formally endorsed by the ACF Committee and Senior Executive.

The final framework is now available on the ACF [webpage](#) and comes into immediate effect.

The final Framework reflects our shared commitment to:

- Enhancing clarity and transparency across academic expectations
- Promoting equity, fairness and inclusivity
- Improving consistency in interpretation and application
- Aligning with international standards of academic excellence
- Supporting quality and impact across academic profiles, promotions and related policies

Implementation and Support

As we move towards implementation, a suite of resources will be made available on the ACF Hub from early February 2026, including:

- The Framework and its associated policy material
- Details of Information Sessions and Training Modules
- Detailed guides for applicants, supervisors and committee members and
- FAQs and practical tools to support preparation for the 2026 promotions cycle

These resources have been designed to ensure a smooth transition to implementation of the new Framework and to offer support to all academic staff in understanding and applying the new Framework in their career journey.

Additionally, a *new Professional Experience to Academic Qualifications Equivalency Policy and Procedures* is under development and will be made available to all staff shortly.
