Purpose:

The purpose of this form is to assign a risk rating to an application for admission to, or change to an existing, Higher Degree by Research (HDR) candidature from a citizen of a <u>sanctions regime</u>. The assignment of a risk rating enables Flinders University to take a risk-based approach in its compliance with <u>Australian sanction laws</u>.

This form is also to be used for the annual review, with respect to compliance with Australian sanction laws, of a HDR candidature from a citizen of a sanctions regime.

Please note: sanctions regimes can be subject to frequent and significant change by the Australian Government. Accordingly, this form is also subject to frequent change. Research, Development & Support (RDS) can provide further advice regarding compliance with United Nations Security Council (multilateral/international) and Australian (unilateral/autonomous) sanctions.

How to complete this form:

- For a new HDR candidature application or any change to the time-based research project of apreviously approved HDR candidature:
 - → Sections A1 and A2 to be completed by the Office of Graduate Research
 - → Sections B, C, and D1 to be completed by the Principal Supervisor
 - → Section E to be completed by the College HDR Coordinator
 - → Section F to be completed by the Dean of Graduate Research
- For the annual sanctions review of a HDR candidature:
 - →Section A1 to be completed by the Office of Graduate Research→Section D2 to be completed by the Principal Supervisor
 - → Section E to be completed by the College HDR Coordinator
 - → Section F to be completed by the Dean of Graduate Research
