
### What is My Research Summary?



#### **Research Summary Overview**





### Step 2 - Select the "Research Summary" from the Left-hand menu.



## What is My Research Summary?





- **1. Course Information** Details the degree program the student is enrolled in (e.g., PhD Doctor of Philosophy).
- **2. EFTSL Summary** Shows the Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL) consumed to date, both at this institution and others. This reflects how much of the program has been completed.
- **3.** Admission and Funding Details Includes the admission date and the student's liability category (e.g., RTP Domestic), indicating funding arrangements.
- **4.** Thesis Details Lists the thesis code, student ID number, title, and expected submission date. This is the core research focus of the student.
- **5. Supervisory Team** Names the principal, associate, and adjunct supervisors, along with their start dates. These are the academic staff guiding the research.
- **6.** Thesis Title Provides the proposed thesis title of the research project.
- **7. Current Enrolment Period** Shows the current study period, enrolment status, and study rate (e.g., full-time or part-time).
- **8. Enrolment History** Provides a timeline of previous enrolment periods and statuses, useful for tracking academic progression.
- 9. Download Button Downloads the PFD to your device
- **10. Printer Button** Opens Printer settings dialog for you to print the document to your local printer.
