PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- [Adelaide Metro](#) is Adelaide's public transport which covers the entire metropolitan region. It includes buses, trains and trams that run from the city to the inner and outer suburbs.
- **Adelaide Metro fares** are the same on buses, trains and trams and remain the same no matter the distance travelled. You can pay with a rechargeable [metroCARD](#), [Adelaide Metro tap and pay](#) ticket by using your credit/debit card or smart device, or the Adelaide Metro [Buy & Go app](#) on trams and buses with transfers to trains departing from the Adelaide Railway Station.
- If you're a full-time student using public transport regularly, you can buy a metroCARD which will allow you to ride on Adelaide's buses, trains and trams at a discount. Full-time students with a valid student ID are eligible for a [concession metroCARD](#):

Free Public transport services

Adelaide has free city connector buses Routes 99A and 99C loop around the CBD and are available Monday to Friday. Routes 98A and 98C follow the same loop around the CBD and extend to North Adelaide. They are available every day.

- Tram routes around the CBD are free. The free zone is the area between the South Terrace stop, Adelaide Entertainment Centre, Festival Plaza and the Botanic Gardens.

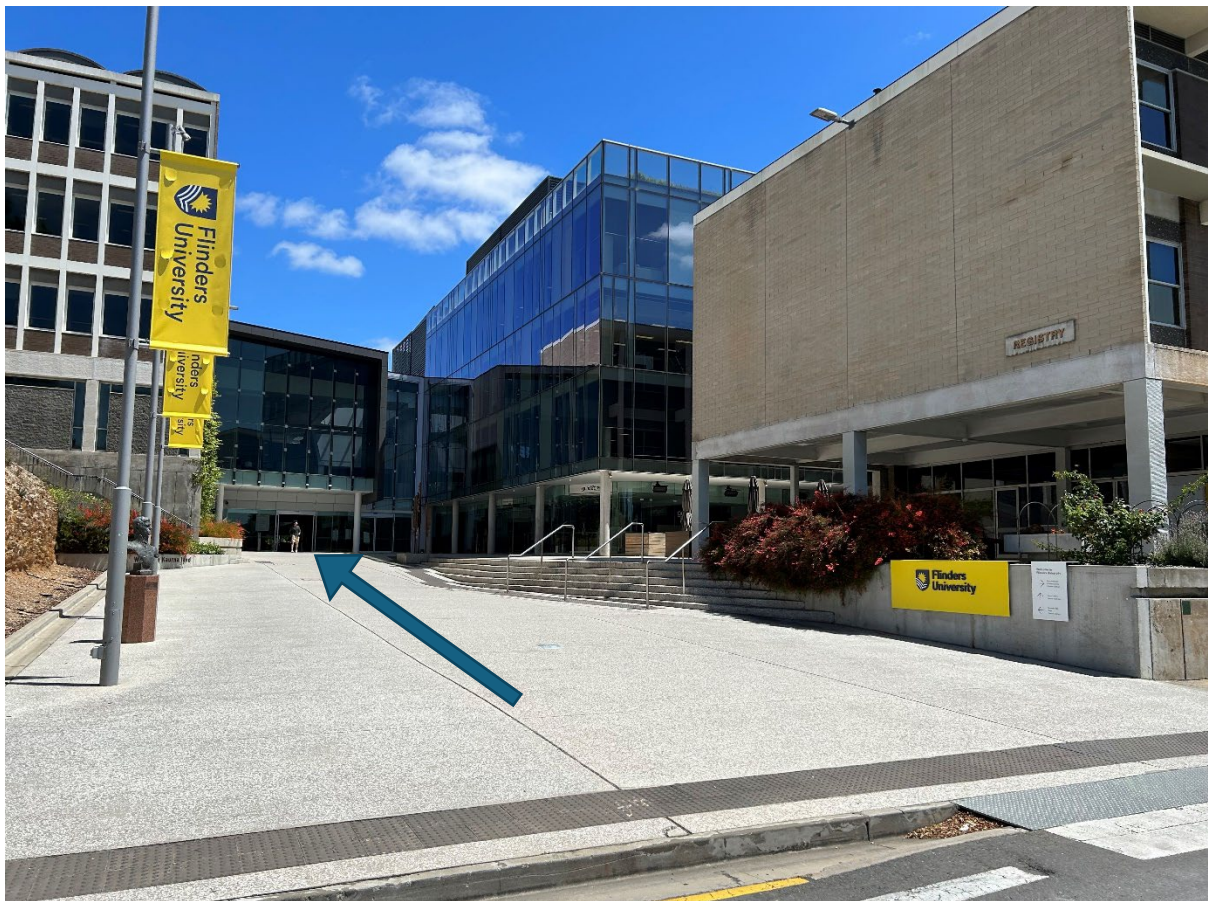

HOW TO FIND ISS AT THE BEDFORD PARK CAMPUS

To find a public transport connection go to [Google maps](#) and enter the starting point of your journey to your destination “Registry Road, Bedford Park”.
When you leave the bus, walk along the footpath until you reach the Registry Building.



Walk towards the entrance of the Student Hub.



When you enter the Student Hub



you can turn left and use the lift to reach Level 1.



Alternatively, you can use the stairs on the right side



to reach Level 1.



At the top of the stairs look for the yellow Flinders International sign and turn left.



After walking through the first glass sliding door turn right to enter the reception area of Flinders International: Welcome !

How to get to the Tonsley Campus

- By train - Flinders Railway Line
The Flinders Railway Line connects the CBD with Flinders University's Bedford Park campus in just 22 minutes. Catch the FLNDRS train and get off at the Tonsley Railway Station to reach the [Tonsley campus](#).
- By bus
To find a bus connection go to [Google Maps](#) and enter the starting point of your journey to your destination "Flinders University at Tonsley, 1284 South Rd, Clovelly Park SA 5042".
- By Campus bus service - Tonsley Link
A frequent free campus bus service is available on weekdays from 7am to 6pm, connecting Tonsley with the Bedford Park campus. For more information and to download the bus schedule app go to [Loop bus - Flinders University](#)

Opening hours and building access

- Tonsley is accessible to everyone between 7:45am and 6pm Monday to Friday. Staff and students can access the lower floors of the Tonsley building 24 hours a day, 7 days a week by using their swipe cards. This includes access on public holidays.
