



POSTGRADUATE VISUAL EFFECTS AND ENTERTAINMENT DESIGN PORTFOLIO GUIDELINES 2022

The portfolio of original work is a great way for us to gauge applicants' passion and enthusiasm for the visual effects and entertainment design (VEED) arts and provides Flinders with an insight of applicants' underpinning skills they wish to build upon.

To be eligible to apply for consideration applicants must:

- Hold a Bachelor degree or equivalent qualification; and
- Submit a portfolio which includes no more than 10 examples of work to demonstrate a range of projects and skills undertaken from personal and/or professional experience.

Some examples of portfolio content can include:

- Illustration and Drawing: observational, life drawing, concept/design sketches and storyboarding;
- Fine Arts: painting, sculpture and/or printmaking projects;
- 2D and 3D design: evidence of creative thinking and following a design process for digital 2D or 3D character, environment, creature, vehicle, or asset design work; model-making, product design, sculpture or ceramics that resulted from designs can also be included;
- Film, Animation, Games, Photography, Television: compositing, editing or production experience held.

The portfolio can also demonstrate a range of projects and competence in several key areas relevant to VEED, including evidence of working through a project from research, design development and concept sketches, regardless of specialism.

The portfolio can include examples of work done in spare time, current job or outside of university study if relevant to VEED. For example, short films or work done as part of a Drama group.

Eligible applicants must submit their portfolio via email to <u>askflinders@flinders.edu.au</u> within ten working days of submitting their application to SATAC. The email subject line should include their SATAC application number for reference.
