

UNIVERSITY OFFERS FAQS

THE MAIN OFFER ROUND IS ON 15 JANUARY, WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- · SATAC will notify you of your offer by email.
- If you've received an offer to your first preference, this will automatically be accepted on your behalf.
- If you received an offer to a lower preference, you'll see
 a status message for your higher preference. You must
 respond accordingly. If you don't, SATAC will assume you
 don't want to be considered for higher preferences.
- Follow the instructions in your SATAC offer letter to begin the enrolment process.
- Now is a good time to check the range of <u>scholarships</u> <u>available</u> to Flinders students.
- It is important to follow the instructions in your offer letter.
 If you do not follow these instructions your offer may lapse.

HOW DO I RESPOND TO MY UNIVERSITY OFFER?

If you receive an offer to your first preference you don't need to accept your offer as this will be done automatically by SATAC on your behalf. However, if you wish to reject this offer you will need to do so by logging into your application on the SATAC website and changing your response.

CAN I RECEIVE MORE THAN ONE OFFER IN EACH OFFER ROUND?

You will only receive one offer in each offer round.

I DIDN'T RECEIVE AN OFFER TO MY FIRST PREFERENCE AND I'M UNSURE WHETHER I SHOULD ACCEPT AN OFFER TO MY LOWER PREFERENCE. WHAT SHOULD I DO?

WHEN DO I HAVE TO RESPOND TO MY UNIVERSITY OFFER?

If you receive an offer to your first preference, you don't need to accept your offer as this will be done automatically on your behalf. However, if you wish to defer or reject this offer you will need to do so by logging into your application and changing your response.

If you receive an offer for one of your lower preferences and wish to accept, you must do so by the date stated in your offer letter from SATAC. Otherwise, your offer may lapse. Make sure you read the details in your offer letter carefully

SHOULD I ACCEPT MY OFFER FROM THE MAIN OFFER ROUND OR WAIT TO SEE IF I GET AN ALTERNATIVE OFFER IN THE NEXT OFFER ROUND?

If you receive an offer to your first preference in the main offer round, you will not receive offers to your lower preferences in subsequent offer rounds. If you wish to be considered for your lower preferences, you will need to change your preferences so that the lower ones in the main offer round are placed higher in your preference list than the offered preference in subsequent rounds. If you don't respond to your offer and you don't receive an offer in a subsequent round, you may miss out on studying at university in 2019.

NOW THAT I HAVE MY UNIVERSITY OFFER, CAN I DEFER?

You can defer your offer for one year in all undergraduate courses at Flinders **except** the following:

HOW DO I DEFER MY OFFER?

Once you have received your SATAC offer letter, if eligible, you can elect to defer your offer through the Flinders Student Information System.

To access the Student Information System, you must first:

- · Activate your student account; and
- · Log in to MyFlinders.

Instructions on how to access the Student Information System are located in the Manage My Offer section of MyFlinders.

Once you have accessed the Student Information System and checked your personal details, you can defer your offer via the 'My Offers' tab. You will need to select the course to be deferred and click on the 'Defer' button. By confirming the selection on the next screen your course offer will be deferred

Follow the instructions in your offer letter and you can begin your enrolment immediately via the <u>MyFlinders webpage</u>.

DO I HAVE TO ATTEND O WEEK?

O Week at Flinders runs from 25 February to 1 March.

O Week, or Orientation Week, helps you transition to university. Although it's not compulsory to attend, we recommend coming along to help you settle in, find your way around, and be introduced to the academic and social life awaiting you at Flinders.

WHAT IF I DON'T LIKE THE DEGREE I'VE STARTED?

If you started studying a degree at Flinders and decided that it wasn't for you, you can apply to transfer to another Flinders degree via internal transfer. In March and April Flinders will offer drop in advice sessions on changing your course.
