OVERVIEW

This unique combined degree will qualify individuals to apply an advanced body of knowledge in a range of contexts for professional practice or scholarship and as a pathway for further learning. Graduates will have advanced knowledge and skills for specialised professional practice, research and lifelong learning.

The course aims to provide a broad foundation of health service management and business knowledge, skills and attitudes to support ethical and global management of health and aged care organisations including private sector, not-for-profit and public organisations. Through experiential learning techniques students will investigate advanced issues in management, develop knowledge and skills to conduct independent industryand discipline-related management projects and/or research, and relate their learning to their individual organisational experience. The course prepares graduates for entry to the Australasian College of Health Service Management in the Associate Fellow membership category.

STUDY PROGRAM

The combined degree course requires the completion of 72 units of study. The program can be completed in two years of full-time study (or the equivalent part-time). The program is offered by the Flinders Business School in the Faculty of Social and Behavioural Sciences and the School of Medicine in the Faculty of Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must hold one of the following:

- · an approved degree or equivalent qualification from an approved tertiary institution and have not less than four years' full-time professional experience in the health or aged care sector following completion of the degree or equivalent qualification
- either the Graduate Certificate in Health Administration or equivalent, or the Graduate Diploma in Health Administration or equivalent from Flinders University and have not less than four years' full-time professional experience in the health or aged care sector
- · the Graduate Diploma in Business Administration or equivalent from Flinders University and have not less than four years' full-time professional experience in the health or aged care sector.

However, the respective Faculty Boards may, under certain circumstances and subject to specific conditions, admit others who can show evidence of fitness for candidature.

All applicants must provide their curriculum vitae providing details of their relevant work experience.



CREDIT

Credit may be available by negotiation on a case-by-case basis.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Potential occupations include roles in the health sector such as HR manager, administration manager, chief operating officer, program co-ordinator, project officer, and residential care manager.

Potential employers include State Government, Federal Government, public hospitals such as the Royal Adelaide, private hospitals such as Calvary Wakefield Private hospital, and aged care providers such as ACH or ECH.

The course prepares graduates for entry to the Australasian College of Health Service Management in the Associate Fellow membership category.
