Flinders' new city campus features an innovative, collaborative learning model that provides real-world experience to prepare students from the moment they step into the workforce.


Our students are empowered to fearlessly share ideas, engage with dynamic industry leaders, and work on authentic case studies and projects.

Fast, flexible and designed for success.


The latest technology for modern learning.

The cutting-edge technology that informs every part of the campus exists for a simple reason – to make the most of our students' learning experience in the way that suits them best.



- broadening professional networks and connections.


At Flinders University, we aspire to every student having an opportunity to apply their skills in an authentic workplace context, through placements, internships or projects.
