WHAT CAN I STUDY?

Some Flinders courses have prerequisite entry requirements. You will need to satisfy these requirements as part of the application.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

You are eligible to apply for the School Recommendation Program if you are:

- applying for a Flinders course starting next year, and
- currently enrolled in Year 12/13 OR
- enrolled in an alternate education pathway (FLO/VET)

HOW TO APPLY

You will be required to:

- apply for a Flinders course through the South Australian Tertiary Admissions Centre (SATAC)
- complete Section A (attaching any relevant documentation and two of your latest school reports)
- arrange for the School Principal or delegate to complete and sign Section B and return to the University

SELECTION

Your application will be considered on a combination of:

- principal/school statement
- applicant statement
- two latest school reports
- overall performance at Year 11/12 studies (including subjects and subject combinations that may not be counted towards an ATAR)
- illustration of achievements in other aspects of life and other studies, where relevant (TAFE/VET/ community involvement/work experience/volunteering).
