Northern Territory

While theoretical content delivered online can be accessed anywhere within the Northern Territory with internet coverage, the clinical skills and practical education will be delivered by practical workshop intensives held in Darwin. This will require students to spend up to 1 or 2 weeks in Darwin each semester.

Regional External Program

The regional external program will allow regional students from South Australia to undertake the Paramedicine degree without needing to relocate to Adelaide. You will be able to perform your coursework online and attend the Bedford Park campus for compulsory practical workshop intensives and clinical exams to meet the practical learning requirements. Please note: Applicants must currently reside and have lived at least two years out of the past six years, or a total of five years since starting primary school, in a remote and/or outer regional area (RA3 - RA5).
