Flinders University Academy Industry Inspiration Scholarship

Terms and Conditions 2023

Scholarship spirit:

Flinders University is proud of our strong linkage with industry. By closely working with our industry partners across different sectors, Flinders University is able to translate our innovative teaching into real world skills and knowledge to benefit our students. From industry placement to joint research and technology innovation, we are constantly expanding our industry network, leading to outstanding outcomes for graduate employment. To support international students who choose to pursue their dream in Creative Industries and in Engineering, the Flinders University Academy launches the Industry Inspiration Scholarship to showcase our firm commitment to uphold student career goals and the journey to their chosen industry.

Value

- A one-off \$2,000 tuition deduction towards the second trimester tuition fee

Eligibility, application and selection

- Available to new students only, enrolling in intakes commencing in 2023 only. Acceptances deferred to 2024 will not be eligible for the scholarship
- Available to new applications submitted or acceptances confirmed after 25 May 2023.
- Available only to full fee-paying international students of any nationality (citizens of Australia and New Zealand and Australian Permanent Residents or other permanent visa holders are ineligible to apply).
- Applicants must hold a valid Flinders Academy packaged offer either Diploma in Creative Industries or Diploma in Engineering.
- Applicants may hold Flinders University Academy the Industry Inspiration Scholarship and other Flinders Academy scholarships concurrently.
- There is no separate scholarship application process for the Industry Inspiration Scholarship. Applications for Diploma in Creative Industries or Diploma in Engineering will automatically be assessed for scholarship eligibility and eligible applicants will be notified with their Letter of Offer to the course. Eligible applicants simply need to return the course Acceptance Form to be awarded.

Exclusions

- Scholarships are not available to students in receipt of financial support from the Australian government, a foreign government, or another Flinders University scholarship.
- Scholarships are not available to students transferring to Flinders University Academy with credit from studies completed at another institution.

Continuing eligibility conditions

- Recipients of the Go Beyond Scholarships must actively support Flinders University in promoting the University and Flinders University Academy globally, including, as required, participating in marketing or promotional activities including but not limited to photo shoots, testimonials and other designated activities.
- Maintain full time enrolment (unless an underload has been authorised by Flinders University Academy. If a scholarship recipient enrolls in less than a full-time load in any semester covered by the scholarship without authorisation from Flinders University Academy that semester's portion of the scholarship is forfeited. The scholarship may be reactivated once the student enrolls in a full-time load in the next semester however, the full value of the scholarship will not be disbursed.
- Maintain continuous enrolment without deferrals or suspensions (unless a temporary suspension has been authorised by Flinders University Academy)
- Maintain international student status for the duration of enrolment.
- Meet payment deadlines for the remaining portion of tuition fees for each study period. The scholarship will be revoked unless all remaining fees are paid by the advertised payment date. In exceptional circumstances Student Financial Services may approve a payment extension or instalment plan, in which case the scholarship can be maintained.

The scholarship will be revoked if:

- any information submitted with the application is found to be false or misleading
- the recipient is awarded another scholarship
- the recipient fails to adhere to the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

Delivery of scholarship

- The scholarship is awarded as a tuition fee reduction and will be paid directly into the student's second trimester tuition fee account.
- Scholarships provide a tuition fee waiver and do not cover the costs of any non-tuition fees, visas, overseas health cover, living expenses or any other costs associated with living in Adelaide or studying at Flinders University.
- There is no financial payout of any unexpended portion of this scholarship, nor is it refundable.
- The scholarship is not transferrable to a third party.
- The scholarship will not be extended beyond the advertised duration or amount unless otherwise advised by Flinders University.
- If a recipient voluntarily withdraws from Flinders University without completing 50% of the units required for the course, the recipient will be liable to repay the value of the scholarship disbursed from the date of admission to the date of withdrawal.

These terms and conditions may be updated during the period of the scholarship. Recipients will be notified via Flinders email account of any changes.
