

English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Express Scholarship

Terms and Conditions 2026

Value

- 30% reduction in tuition fees.
- Scholarship value is the percentage reduction specified above.
- Valid for the duration of the EAP course of study at Flinders University Academy, providing continuing eligibility requirements are met.

Eligibility, application, and selection

- Available to new students only commencing an EAP course from 4 June 2026 onwards.
- For applicants who have satisfied the English proficiency requirements for their Flinders course, but the EAP is required to ensure compliance of their student visa conditions, e.g. maintain full time studies so that there is no study gap between courses as this cannot be greater than 2 months during a compulsory academic year.
- Available only to full fee-paying international students.
- There is no separate scholarship application process for the English for Academic Purposes Express Scholarship. Applications for English for Academic Purposes will automatically be assessed for scholarship eligibility and eligible applicants will be notified within their Letter of Offer to the course. Eligible applicants simply need to return the course Acceptance Form for the scholarship to be awarded.

Exclusion

- Scholarship is not available to students in receipt of financial support from the Australian government, a foreign government, or another Flinders University scholarship unless written approval by Flinders University Academy is received.
- Scholarship is not available to students who are packaging an EAP course to meet the required English language level for course entry.

Continuing eligibility conditions

- Recipients of the scholarship must actively support Flinders University in promoting the University and Flinders University Academy globally, including, as required, participating in marketing or promotional activities including but not limited to photo shoots, testimonials, and other designated activities.

- Recipients must maintain full-time enrolment (unless an underload has been authorised by Flinders University Academy). Failure to maintain full-time enrolment or failure to complete the EAP may result in not meeting the conditions of the Flinders course offer.
- If a scholarship recipient enrolls in less than a full-time load in any study period covered by the scholarship without authorisation from Flinders University Academy, that study period's portion of the scholarship is forfeited and the student will be required to pay the full-tuition fee.
- The scholarship may be reinstated once the student enrolls in a full-time load in the study period. However, the full value of the scholarship will not be reinstated.
- Maintain continuous enrolment without deferrals or suspensions (unless a temporary suspension has been authorised by Flinders University Academy).
- Maintain international student status for the duration of enrolment.
- Meet payment deadlines for the remaining portion of tuition fees for each study period.
- The scholarship will be revoked unless all remaining fees are paid by the advertised payment date. In exceptional circumstances Student Financial Services may approve a payment extension or instalment plan, in which case the scholarship can be maintained.
- The scholarship will be revoked if:
 - Any information submitted with the application is found to be false or misleading.
 - The recipient is awarded another scholarship without permission from Flinders University Academy.
 - If the recipient fails to adhere to the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

Delivery of scholarship:

- The scholarship is awarded as a tuition fee reduction and will be reflected in the student's tuition fee account.
- Scholarships provide a tuition fee reduction and do not cover the costs of any non-tuition fees, visas, overseas health cover, living expenses or any other costs associated with living in Adelaide or studying at Flinders University Academy.
- There is no financial payout of any unexpended portion of this scholarship, nor is it refundable.
- The scholarship is not transferrable to a third party.
- The scholarship will not be extended beyond the advertised duration or amount unless otherwise advised by Flinders University Academy.
- If a recipient voluntarily withdraws from Flinders University Academy without completing 50% of course, the recipient will be liable to repay the value of the scholarship disbursed from the date of admission to the date of withdrawal.

These terms and conditions may be updated during the period of the scholarship. Recipients will be notified via Flinders email account of any change.
