
### Getting to Flinders

# How to Apply

Applying for a Flinders University Academy program is easy. Whether you choose to apply directly or through an authorised agent in your country, we are available to assist you through the process.

## 1. Select your Academy program

Browse the programs we offer and discover which program is right for you.

## 2. Find an agent

Many students prefer to use an agent to assist them with the application process. We have a wide range of trusted agents who you can contact to help you.

Students from certain countries must submit their application through a registered Flinders agent.

## 3. Apply online

You can apply to study at Flinders University via an authorised agent in your country, or you may submit your application yourself.

## 4. Obtain certified documents

All academic documentation submitted to Flinders electronically must be certified. We also require certified copies of passports for applicants from some countries. Original documentation may be submitted by post or in person, but we are unable to guarantee the return of these original documents.

## 5. Submit your application and documents

You will need to upload all required documents prior to being able to submit your application so it is important you have these ready.

## 6. Your application is now complete

Flinders University will send you and/or your agent an email confirming we have received your application.

# Admission Process

Admission to Flinders University Academy is a simple process. Here's our step-by-step guide.

## 1. Receive your offer letter

Upon success of your application, you will receive an Offer of Admission to a program at Flinders Academy. This will be emailed to you, or you can also view it in our International Application System if you applied yourself, or your agent will have a copy if you applied via an agent.

## 2. Accept your offer

Accept your Offer of Admissions through our International Application System. Ensure you upload your signed Acceptance Form along with any other documents as requested as part of your offer.

## 3. Pay your deposit

Your initial payment is due once you have accepted your Offer of Admissions. Your Offer of Admission will contain details regarding how much your initial payment will be.

Some programs may require you to pay your deposit by a deadline. This information will be confirmed in your offer letter. At this time, you must also pay your Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) visa.

If you are pre-arranging your own OSHC, please ensure you provide evidence to us as soon as possible. After you have made your initial payment, remaining payments must be made by the topic due date. Students are charged per topic, based on their enrolment.

## 4. Under 18 requirements

If you are under 18 when you arrive in Australia you must have approved accommodation and welfare arrangements in place before your student visa will be granted.

## 5. Apply for your visa

Once your payment has been processed, we will issue a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) - you must have a CoE to apply for a visa.

## 6. Prepare for your departure

We are ready to welcome you to Flinders Academy. Once Flinders has received your tuition fee payment, you will receive a copy of the pre-departure guide to assist you with your arrival in Adelaide.
