

## Flinders International High School Scholarship

### *Terms and Conditions*

#### Categories and Value

Scholarship	Value	Requirements
Flinders International High School Scholarship	15% reduction in tuition fees for the duration of the course.	Applicants must achieve an ATAR or equivalent between 65.00 and 69.95 and will be awarded the scholarship if their ATAR exceeds the minimum course entry score by 5 points.
		Applicants must achieve the Flinders University Academy International Foundation Studies Program overall % grade between 65 to 69 and will be awarded the scholarship if their score exceeds the minimum course entry score by 5 points.
	25% reduction in tuition fees for the duration of the course.	Applicants must achieve an ATAR or equivalent between 70 and 79.95 and will be awarded the scholarship if their ATAR exceeds the minimum course entry score by 5 points.
		Applicants must achieve the Flinders University Academy International Foundation Studies Program overall % grade between 70 to 79 and exceed the minimum course entry score by 5 points.
	30% reduction in tuition fees for the duration of the course.	Applicants must achieve a minimum ATAR or equivalent of 80 or above.
		Applicants must achieve the Flinders University Academy International Foundation Studies Program overall % grade of 80 and above.

- The scholarship is valid for the duration of study in the course, providing continuing eligibility requirements are met.
- Scholarship value is the percentage reduction specified above.
- Applicants will be considered for the scholarship during the application assessment process, and therefore there is no separate application process.

#### Eligibility, application and selection

- Available only to full fee-paying international applicants of any nationality (citizens of Australia and New Zealand and Australian Permanent Residents or other permanent visa holders are not eligible).
- Available to direct-entry high school curriculum or Flinders University Academy International Foundation Studies students packaged with English pathways.
- Students packaged with Flinders University Academy Diploma programs are not eligible.
- Eligible applicants will be notified in their Letter of Offer to the course if they have been awarded the scholarship.
- Eligible applicants simply need to return the course Acceptance Form and the Scholarship Acceptance Form for the scholarship to be awarded.

- Deferring students are eligible for the scholarship if it remains active and is available in the intake they have deferred to.

#### **Exclusions**

- Selected courses are excluded from the scholarship. See list of excluded course(s) in Appendix 1.
- Scholarships are not available to current Flinders University students who are transferring from a Flinders University course without the scholarship into an eligible scholarship course
- Scholarships are not available to students in receipt of financial support from the Australian government, a foreign government, or another Flinders University scholarship.
- Scholarships are not available to students transferring to Flinders with credit from studies completed at another institution.
- Scholarships are not available to students studying the full degree off-campus in external study mode.

#### **Continuing eligibility conditions**

- Recipients of the Flinders International High School Scholarship Australia must actively support Flinders University in promoting the university globally, including, as required, participating in marketing or promotional activities including but not limited to photo shoots, testimonials and other designated activities.

#### **All recipients must**

- Maintain enrolment in the initial course and/or specialisation as confirmed on the Letter of Offer, however:
- Transferring to a course within the same discipline may allow the recipient to continue receiving the scholarship in the new course – e.g. Bachelor of Education (Primary) to Bachelor of Education (Secondary) – however transfers to ineligible courses will result in loss of scholarship.
- Where transferring to an eligible course but has a higher scholarship minimum score, the recipient must meet the higher score to continue receiving the scholarship.
- Maintain a GPA of 4.0 on a 7.0 scale after 36 units of study. If a recipient's GPA drops below 4.0 the scholarship will be withheld in the following semester and the student will be charged the full tuition fee for that semester. If the student's GPA the following semester is above the 4.0 threshold the scholarship will be reinstated.
- Maintain full time enrolment (unless an underload has been authorised by Flinders International). If a scholarship recipient enrolls in less than a full-time load in any semester covered by the scholarship without authorisation from Flinders International, that semester's portion of the scholarship is forfeited. The scholarship may be reactivated once the student enrolls in a full-time load in the next semester however, the full value of the scholarship will not be disbursed.
- Maintain continuous enrolment without leave or suspensions (unless a temporary suspension has been authorised by Flinders International).
- Maintain international student status for the duration of enrolment in the course.
- Meet payment deadlines for the remaining portion of tuition fees for each study period. The scholarship will be revoked unless all remaining fees are paid by the advertised payment date. In exceptional circumstances Student Financial Services may approve a payment extension or instalment plan, in which case the scholarship can be maintained.

- The scholarship is not transferrable to any other institution. If a recipient enrolls in cross institutional study those tuition fees are not covered by the scholarship and the value of the scholarship applied to the Flinders tuition will be reduced pro-rata.

**The scholarship will be revoked if**

- Any information submitted with the application is found to be false or misleading.
- The recipient is awarded another scholarship.
- The recipient fails to adhere to the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

**Delivery of scholarship**

- The scholarship is awarded as a tuition fee reduction and will be paid directly into the student's tuition fee account.
- Scholarships provide a tuition fee reduction and do not cover the costs of any non-tuition fees, visas, overseas health cover, living expenses or any other costs associated with living in Adelaide or studying at Flinders University.
- There is no financial payout of any unspent portion of this scholarship, nor is it refundable.
- The scholarship is not transferrable to a third party.
- The scholarship will not be extended beyond the advertised duration or amount unless otherwise advised by Flinders University.
- If a recipient voluntarily withdraws from Flinders University without completing 50% of the units required for the course, the recipient will be liable to repay the value of the scholarship disbursed from the date of admission to the date of withdrawal.

These terms and conditions may be amended/updated after the scholarship has been awarded. Recipients will be notified via Flinders email account of any changes.
