

Flinders University Kickstart Scholarship 2025 & 2026

Terms and Conditions

Scholarship spirit:

Flinders University has been known as a student-centric university since its establishment. We believe students are the soul of our campus, and the student experience is an important part of their journey. To facilitate a smooth path for students to study at Flinders University, we are excited to share our Flinders University Kickstart Scholarship, which is designed to make a positive impact on student experience.

Value

- 20% reduction in tuition fees
- Scholarship value is the percentage reduction specified above
- Valid for the duration of the course of study at Flinders University, providing continuing eligibility requirements are met

Eligibility, application and selection

- Available to new international students commencing in Semester 2, 2025 (July and October intakes), Semester 1, 2026 or Semester 2, 2026 (July and October intakes)
- International students, both onshore and offshore, are eligible for this scholarship
- To be eligible for this scholarship, students applying for an undergraduate degree need to meet all admission eligibility requirements for the selected course
- To be eligible for this scholarship, students applying for a postgraduate degree need to meet all admission eligibility requirements for the selected course.
- There is no separate application process for the scholarship. Applications will automatically be assessed for eligibility, and eligible applicants will be notified with their Letter of Offer to the course. Eligible applicants simply need to return the course Acceptance Form to be awarded.
- Available only to full fee-paying international students of any nationality who will commence a Flinders University degree in Semester 2, 2025 (July and October intakes), Semester 1, 2026 or Semester 2, 2026 (July and October intakes) (citizens of Australia and New Zealand and Australian Permanent Residents or other permanent visa holders are ineligible to apply).

Exclusions

- The scholarship is not available to students in receipt of financial support from the Australian government, a foreign government, or another Flinders University scholarship.

Continuing eligibility conditions

- Recipients of the scholarship must actively support Flinders University in promoting the University globally, including as required, participating in marketing or promotional activities, including but not limited to photo shoots, testimonials and other designated activities.
- Maintain international student status for the duration of enrolment.
- Maintain a minimum Flinders GPA of 4.5 after enrolment of a minimum of 36 units of study.
- The scholarship will be revoked if:
 - any information submitted with the application is found to be false or misleading.
 - the recipient is awarded another scholarship without notifying Flinders University
 - the recipient fails to adhere to the terms and conditions of the scholarship.

Delivery of scholarship

- The scholarship is awarded as a tuition fee reduction and will be paid directly into the student's tuition fee account
- The scholarship provides a tuition fee waiver and does not cover the costs of any non-tuition fees, visas, overseas health cover, living expenses or any other costs associated with living in Adelaide or studying at Flinders University
- There is no financial payout of any unexpended portion of this scholarship, nor is it refundable.
- The scholarship is not transferable to a third party.
- The scholarship will not be extended beyond the advertised duration or amount unless otherwise advised by Flinders University.

These terms and conditions may be updated during the scholarship period. Recipients will be notified via their Flinders email account of any changes.
