The Sustainability Advisory Group was formed in 2017 with the primary purpose of assisting the University to develop and deliver a strategy and plan to improve our sustainability performance and contribute to delivery of the University 2025 Agenda.

The purpose of the advisory group is:

1. To advocate and champion sustainability in research, teaching and operations
2. To assist in delivering on the vision and actions of the Sustainability Plan to 2025
3. To consider new project proposals in context of delivering the Plan
4. To assist with development of internal/external funding requests
5. To participate in delivery of projects consistent with role or research speciality
6. To review project outcomes in line with Plan

Membership

Current membership is comprised of interested staff and students with a role in or passion for sustainability in operations, education and research. Current terms will expire at the end of 2021.

Future membership will comprise of the following:

- Vice President – Corporate Services
- 2 x Representatives from Property, Facilities and Development
- University Principal Sustainability Strategist
- Representative from each College
- Up to 3 x interested general staff members
- FUSA Environment Officer
- Up to 3 x students

A call for membership will be conducted start of 2022.

Meetings two per year.

Committee members can send a proxy on their behalf.

To constitute an official meeting, a quorum of 50% of members plus 1 (or 7 members) must be present.
